"The 2008 Tempranillo (87% Tempranillo, 9% Graciano and 4% Cabernet Sauvignon) **could easily compete with the equally priced values that emerge from Spain.** There are 5,400 cases so availability should not be a problem for most readers. Broad black cherry and black currant fruit notes intermixed with spice box notes are followed by an elegant round, lush, sexy medium-bodied wine that is meant to be consumed over the next 2-3 years.

High quality, appealing, value-priced wines emerge from winemaker Dan Cederquist under the Matchbook label."
