"The 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon Lake County (87% Cabernet Sauvignon and the rest Petit Verdot and Syrah) is a surprisingly good effort. Its opaque ruby/purple color is accompanied by abundant black currant fruit intermixed with a hint of blueberries. **The price is ridiculous for a wine of this quality.** Consume it over the next 2-4 years.
