BLEND: 76% Malbec, 13% Cabernet Sauvignon, 11% Petit Verdot

Malbec, the red grape Argentina made famous. A medium-bodied wine for those who love Merlot and Pinot Noir, but are seeking something different.

TASTE: Juicy red and black berry flavors with a hint of cherry and a touch of earthiness. The full flavors belie the soft tannins making this an extremely approachable and appealing red wine.

FOOD PAIRING: Steak with chimichurri sauce, roast duck, pork tacos, Osso Buco.



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
